REYGANS SMART LENA
2018 STALLION SERVICE CONTRACT

1. Elizabeth Whipple (Stallion Owner) hereby reserves one breeding to **Reygans Smart Lena**, AQHA #**4900611** (GBED N/GBED) for the mare _____, Reg# _____, owned by _____ (Mare Owner) for the breeding fee of **\$850.00** payable to Elizabeth Whipple, to use during the 2018 breeding season, March 1st to July 1st. A separate contract is required for each breeding for this mare if more than one pregnancy (via embryo transfer) is desired.
2. Owner must attach a copy of the mare's registration papers to this agreement and provide all other information as requested.
3. The mare must be in a healthy and sound breeding condition.
4. If the stallion should die or become unfit for service prior to the mare getting in foal, the breeding fee shall be refunded.
5. Should any foal born to the mare, pursuant to this contract, not stand, suck or survive 15 days, the Mare Owner shall be entitled to a re-breed the following year for this mare or a substitute mare to be approved by Stallion Owner. This "Live Foal Guarantee" will only be valid for the Mare Owner if notifies the Stallion owner of the death of the foal 1 week after the foal's death. This notification must be accompanied by a statement from a licensed veterinarian stating the foal is not a "Live Foal" and the cause of death if known.
6. In the event that the mare aborts the Mare Owner shall certify to the Stallion Owner that the mare was accurately and properly administered vaccines to prevent the mare from aborting, such as the correct dosage of Rhinopneumonitis on the fifth, seventh, and ninth month of pregnancy as well as administered a vaccine for EEE, WEE, FLU, RHINO, and TETANUS on the tenth month of pregnancy. Mare will then be eligible for re-breeding the following breeding season.
7. Rebreed privileges are for the following year only. The breeding will not be refunded. If the Mare Owner fails to rebred the following year than any and all fees will be forfeited, the right to rebred cancelled and the Stallion Owner will be released from all obligations of this contract.
8. All Semen collection fees shall be paid in advance by the Mare Owner to **Goodell Veterinary Clinic, 7509 S. Sixth Street, Klamath Falls, Oregon. 541-882-4556**
9. The Stallion will be collected on a schedule. It is the Mare Owners responsibility to contact Goodell Veterinary Clinic and become advised of that schedule.
10. The Mare owner must give a **24-hour advance** notice to Goodell Veterinary Clinic prior to shipment.
11. The Mare Owner agrees to comply with all appropriate Breed registry requirements concerning the use of cooled semen. Consequently, it is the Mare Owner's responsibility to return the signed Semen Collection / Insemination Certificate to Outback Stallion Station and a signed copy to the registry.
12. Breeder's Certificate will be issued for the foal when the mare has produced a live foal from this breeding and all expenses have been paid in full.
13. If it should become necessary for the Stallion Owner to retain the services of an attorney to enforce its rights under the terms of this contract, including but not limited to t the collections of any sums due, the Mare Owner will pay Stallion Owner all expenses and costs, including reasonable and necessary attorney's fees incurred by Stallion Owner in enforcing this contract.

14. This contract is non-transferable or assignable without prior written consent from Stallion Owner
